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1. Drill Site "A" was placed 3607 links east of Lane's Shaft, this being the position occupied by the drilling plant. Due to boggy condition of ground the plant could not be readily shifted to the point 34 chains east of Lane's Shaft. The R.L. value for Drill Site "A" is 454.2 feet.
2. Drill Site "B" was placed 20' west of the fence at the point 18 chains north of the southeast corner of Portion 42 Parish of Coorabin. The R.L. value for Drill Site "B" is 435.3 feet.
3. The position of the Military Bore is 12 chains on a magnetic bearing of 351 degrees from the southeast corner of that part of Portion 39 Parish of Oaklands, lying to the west of the Railway line. The R.L. value for the Military Bore is 488.5 feet.
4. The position of the Town Bore is approximately as shown on our 20 chains to the inch plan. The R.L. value for the Town Bore is 481 feet.
5. Dine's Bore is about 16 chains south and 1 chain east of the northwest corner of Portion 31, Parish of Oaklands. The R.L. value for Dine's Bore is about 487 feet.

The above information is shown plotted on a helio of our 20 chain to the inch plan, number 664.
