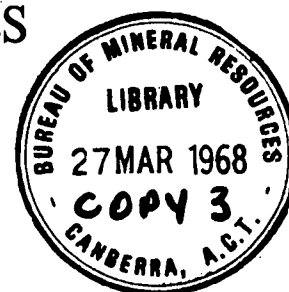

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BIBLIOGRAPHY OF THE MESOZOIC PALAEOLOGY
OF AUSTRALIA AND EASTERN NEW GUINEA

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The larger Australian fossils of Mesozoic age have been the subject of study by palaeontologists, British and Australian alike, for the last hundred and ten years. If we take the number of papers published during any decade on these fossils as a rough guide, it would appear, that interest in them has been maintained fairly steadily throughout this whole period. The topic has, however, not only never been exhausted, but during the last few years has attracted an even greater number of students.

It would seem, on the one hand, that we are on the threshold of further discoveries, while, on the other, much revisional work still remains to be done. Indeed, even at this moment Mesozoic faunas are being revised and new ones described. Stratigraphic units which contain them are named, dated, and correlated with each other or their sequences established. The status, age, and correlation of long established units are being revised. Thus the time is not yet ripe for a summary of our knowledge, though it may be considerable.

R.W. Day, Australian National University, and P.J.G. Fleming, Queensland Geological Survey, are currently working on Cretaceous marine macrofossils of the Great Artesian Basin in Queensland; N.H. Ludbrook, Geological Survey of South Australia, has recently published work on similar fossils from the South Australian portion of the Great Artesian Basin; I have tackled the Cretaceous faunas in the Northern Territory (Skwarko, 1967), and currently in Western Australia and Queensland; the revision of the marine Jurassic faunas of Western Australia is under way. But it is in the Triassic that the most spectacular discoveries have been

made in the last few years. Recently, Dickins and McTavish (1963) announced the discovery of the first marine fauna of Triassic age from the Australian continent. Shortly afterwards Denmead (1964) announced, and Fleming (1966) described, Lower Triassic fauna from Queensland, while I described the first marine macrofaunas from New Guinea mainland (Skwarko, 1967).

It is because of this expanded interest in the local Mesozoic faunas that it seems desirable to provide as many aids to study as possible. It is hoped that the bibliography which is presented below will ^{be} one such aid. In the following pages I have listed all the publications known to me which describe, list, indeed only mention Mesozoic fossils of the larger type both in Australia and New Guinea. For the ease of reference the bibliography is both in the alphabetical and chronological order, and fossils which it covers exclude only the micro-organisms, both the marine and the non-marine, and the plant remains. This bibliography will, in time, be published in a Bureau of Mineral Resources Bulletin and the reason for its present form is to afford opportunity to add to lists any references which may have been omitted. I would be grateful for any help in this matter.

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
