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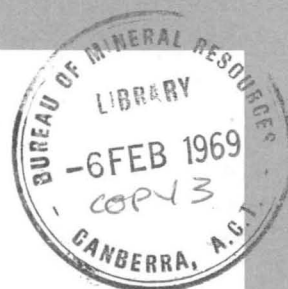

A BIBLIOGRAPHY OF AUSTRALIAN PERMIAN INVERTEBRATES

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The list that follows was compiled in the first place as an aid to editing. So much of the Bureau's work in the last twenty years, both stratigraphical and palaeontological, has centred on the Permian that a check list ready to hand became necessary; and no such list has been issued since Branson's 'Bibliographic Index of Permian Invertebrates' (Geol. Soc. Amer. Mem. 26) in 1945.

The pace has quickened since then: though the rate of publication may not have risen greatly, many of the post-war papers are monographic in treatment, and cover an enormous amount of new ground. From the Bureau alone, for instance, monographs have been issued on Foraminifera (Crespin, 1958), Polyzoa (Crockford, 1957; Wass, 1968), Brachiopoda (Coleman, 1957; Thomas, 1958, 1969; Campbell, 1965), and Bivalvia (Dickins, 1963; Runnegar, 1968).

Inevitably, this bibliography will have omissions. I owe my palaeontological colleagues, and Dr R.E. Wass of the University of Sydney, a debt of gratitude for checking it and pointing out omissions which I have rectified; but some must remain, and I should be grateful to any reader who would notify me of omissions, so that they may be made good in a later supplement.

The list of titles is followed by taxonomic and geographical indexes. Though these are as complete as I can make them, some papers have not been available to me, so that I have not been able to analyse them for their palaeontological and geographical content. This is another source of omission and error that others may be able to remedy.
