The series of camples from the depth of 1,260 feet down to 1,480 feet is in continuation of that reported upon on 14/10/48.

The specimens consist of grey, carbonaceous sandstones and shales containing a few indeterminate plant remains. It was suggested in the previous report (14/10/48) that the lithology from 1,200 feet down to 1260 feet was similar to that of the Jurassic rocks in the Geelong area. Examination of the samples from 1,260 feet down to 1,480 feet indicates that this characteristic lithology is still present.

No fossil evidence is available for a definite determination of age.
