The samples are listed in descending order.

- 1. Fawnish, micaceous, carbonaceous shale and sandy shale.
- 2. Dark grey to fawnish mudstone with indeterminate plant remains.
- 3. Dark grey to fawnish mudstone with indeterminate plant remains.
- 4. Grey carbonaceous mudstone and sandy shale.
- 5. Similar to Sample 4.
- 6. Indeterminate plant remains.

It is impossible to give an age to the above samples owing to the poor preservation of the plant remains. It is suggested that a further search at this locality should produce specimens which could be determined.
