No. 912 8 miles S.40E. of Mt. Alexander.

Cream to pale ochreous, fine to coarse grained sandstone with angular quartz grains and flakes of white mica. No microfossils.

No. 930 25 miles S.75E. of Mt. Alexander

Pale pinkish siltstone with mica and fine angular to subangular quartz grains. No microfossils.

No. 973 Slopes of Mt. Fenton, Kalyeda Property.

Ferruginous sandstone and mudstone. No microfossils.

No. 974 7 miles S.45E. from Mt. James, Kalyeda
Property.

(a) Dense limestone. No fossils.

(b) Calcareous sandstone. No fossils.

No palaeontological evidence is present in any of these samples to indicate age.
