## WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

Roport No. 1949/2 (Pal. Sor. No. 2)

Ho. 623 1 Mile Morthwost of Mt. Smith. Poole Rongo.

Buff coloured calcaroous sandstone with a little ironstaining, and composed of fine to coarse angular quartz grains. No microfossils.

No. 629 # Mile South of Mt. Smith. Poole Range.

Dark buff coloured, moderately coarse, calcarcous sandstone with dark grey inclusions, and fine angular quartz grains. No microfossils.

No. 631 4 Mile North 200 West of Mt. Smith. Poole Range.

Buff coloured calcarcous sandstone composed of angular quartz grains. No microfossils.

No palaeontological evidence is available in these rocks to suggest an age for them.
