Report No. 1949/2  
(Pal. Ser. No. 2)

No. 623 1 Mile Northwest of Mt. Smith, Poole Range.

Buff coloured calcareous sandstone with a little ironstaining, and composed of fine to coarse angular quartz grains. No microfossils.

No. 629 1/2 Mile South of Mt. Smith, Poole Range.

Dark buff coloured, moderately coarse, calcareous sandstone with dark grey inclusions, and fine angular quartz grains. No microfossils.

No. 631 1/2 Mile North 20° West of Mt. Smith, Poole Range.

Buff coloured calcareous sandstone composed of angular quartz grains. No microfossils.

No palaeontological evidence is available in these rocks to suggest an age for them.
