Notes on the Samples.

The present series of samples from 1460 feet down to 1619 feet is in continuation of that reported upon on 19/3/46.

No fossils are present, but it is suggested that the samples from 1460 feet down to 1533 feet are of Lower Cretaceous age. No fossils evidence is available to indicate the age of the samples from 1554 feet down to 1619 feet.
