## TORO SYMUNAVIOR OF THRUTER SAMPLES FROM

## - Report No. 1945/27 -

The series of samples examined from 2254 feet down and 4554 feet in No. 2 Bore, Boronga, is in continuation of that reported upon 30th May, 1942.

The samples, which consist of carbon-accous sandstone and grey shale down to 3054 feet and of fine to coarse sandstones from 3104 feet down to 4554 feet, contain no micro-fossils. A few shall fragments of plant remains indeterminate are recorded from 2404-2504 feet.

There is no fossil evidence to indicate the age of the bads.
