MICRO-EXAMINATION OF FURTHER SAMPLES FROM  
BORONGA NO. 2 BORE, NORTHERN NEW SOUTH WALES.

- Report No. 1945/27 -

The series of samples examined from 2254 feet down and 4554 feet in No. 2 Bore, Boronga, is in continuation of that reported upon 30th May, 1942.

The samples, which consist of carbonaceous sandstone and grey shale down to 3054 feet and of fine to coarse sandstones from 3104 feet down to 4554 feet, contain no micro-fossils. A few small fragments of plant remains indeterminate are recorded from 2404-2504 feet.

There is no fossil evidence to indicate the age of the beds.
